Pre-emption of Right of Way for Ditch & Location of Water.

To whom these Presents may Concern, Know ye. That G. A. Emery of
 the County of Multnomah, in the State of Oregon, a Citizen of
 the United States, do hereby declare and publish as a legal
 record in all the world, that I claim, and have a valid
 right to the occupation, possession and enjoyment of all
 and singular, that tract or parcel of land lying and being
 in the County of Skamania, in the State of Washington for
 the exclusive right of way for the purpose of constructing
 a flume or water ditch from the Columbia River on the
 North Bank of said stream to a point on said stream more
 particularly described as follows: commencing at a point
 on the North bank of said river about seven hundred
 and fifty (750) feet above the Upper Cascade Rapids, and
 running thence down stream along the North Bank of
 said river ten thousand (10,000) feet more or less.

I also claim, and have a valid right to the enjoyment and
 use of ten thousand cubic feet per second of water from
 said stream for power and manufacturing purposes, to be
 conveyed through such flume or water ditch to said point
 on said stream above mentioned together with all and singular
 the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or
