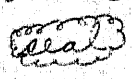

Catherine Haffey to James Haffey and John T. Haffey.

I, Catherine Haffey of Cape Horn, Skamania County, State of Washington, for and in consideration of one dollar (\$1.00), and other considerations - to wit: for the better support maintenance and livelihood of the said Catherine Haffey in case of sickness or accident of said Catherine Haffey, the said James Haffey and John T. Haffey her sons, shall give her good care and attention; and in case of the failure of James Haffey and John T. Haffey to comply with these requirements, this assignment shall become null & void otherwise it shall remain in full force and effect.

This instrument assigns unto the said James Haffey and John T. Haffey the following described tract or parcel of land to wit, beginning at the Southeast corner of the Homestead set apart for Catherine Haffey, widow of William Haffey deceased out of the estate of said William Haffey deceased, thence west along the South line of said estate of William Haffey, deceased, to the Southeast corner of that tract or portion of land set apart for Frank E. Haffey out of said estate thence North to the North line of said estate,

being the Northeast Corner of that tract or portion of land set apart for Frank E. Haffey out of said estate thence east along the North line of said estate to the North West Corner of that tract or portion of land set apart for Cornelius Haffey out of said estate.
