

Catherine Haffey "to" Wm Haffey et al.

This Indenture, made this 25th day of November, 1895 between Catherine Haffey, widow, of Skamania County, State of Washington, the party of the first part, and William Haffey, Frank Edward Haffey and Cornelius Haffey, her sons, of the same County and State, the parties of the second part, Witnesseth:-

That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the love and affection which the said party of the first part has and bears unto the said parties of the second part, as also for the better support, maintenance and livelihood of the said parties of the second part, does by these presents give, grant, alien and confirm unto the said William Haffey four-ninths ($\frac{4}{9}$ ths), unto Frank Edward Haffey four-ninths ($\frac{4}{9}$ ths) and unto Cornelius Haffey one-ninth ($\frac{1}{9}$ th) of the following described tract or parcel of land, to-wit:-

Commencing on the South line of the estate of the late William Haffey, deceased, at the Southeast corner of the homestead heretofore set apart by order of the Court for Mrs Catherine Haffey, widow of the said William Haffey, deceased, and her minor son, Cornelius Haffey, and running thence West along said South line fifty-four (54) rods and nine (9) links; thence North one hundred and sixty (160) rods to the North line of the estate of the said William Haffey deceased; thence along said North line One hundred and fifty (150) rods and sixteen (16) links to the North West corner of the portion of land set apart out of said estate for William Haffey; thence South along the West line of said parcel of land to set apart out of said estate for said William Haffey, as aforesaid to the North line of the parcel of land set apart out of said estate for Bernard Haffey; thence West along said North line of said parcel so set apart for said Bernard Haffey, as aforesaid, twenty-two (22) rods and thirteen (13) links; thence South to the North east corner of said homestead; thence West along the said North line to the North West
