

Notice of Appropriation of Water.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, desiring to avail himself of the rights and privileges provided by law for the appropriation of water, does hereby appropriate of the water being and flowing in and from the creek the name of which is unknown, which creek flows through the North-east $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 2 North of Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian and empties into Greenleaf Creek in the North-east $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16 in said Township 2, North of Range 7 East, in Skamania County, Washington, to the extent of 3 cubic feet per second of time, which claim the undersigned makes for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.

The water hereby appropriated to be taken out at or near the point where this notice is posted, to wit, at or near the center of the North-east $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 2 North of Range 7 East.

The water to be taken from said place of diversion by means of flumes, pipes or ditches or any of said means as may be convenient or necessary. The water so converted to be used for manufacturing, power, water supply, domestic and irrigation purposes in Sections 17, 20, and 21 in said Township 2 North of Range 7 East.
