Notice of Water Right

Notice is hereby given that I, the undersigned, do appropriate and claim the water in hollows brook to the extent of one cubic foot per second of time and I hereby intend to divert said water at the following place: About 400 feet east from where said hollows creek intersects the northline of the N-E quarter of Sec. 25 T. 3 N. R. 8 E. W. M. The course of said water line, ditch or pipe from said point of diversion will be in a southerly direction until it crosses the line between the N-1/2 and S-1/2 of said N-E 1/4 of said Section, thereupon in a southerly direction to hollows Brook Springs Water. Said water so appropriated is for domestic and power purposes and will be converted by pipe, ditch or flume to said place of intended usage.
