CLAIM OF LOGGER'S LIEN

SUNSET LOGGING CO., a corporation, GRAM LUMBER COMPANY, a corporation, LOG TRANSPORT, INC., a corporation, WEYERHAEUSER COMPANY, a corporation, PACIFIC LUMBER AND SHIPPING COMPANY, a corporation, and C & E LUMBER COMPANY.

NOTICE is hereby given that LONNIE RIEDL of Toledo, Lewis County, Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of saw logs and manufactured lumber, being in excess of 500,000 feet in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, Washington, U. S. Forest Service Sale No. 01322, commonly referred to as Wakefield Sale located in Section 27, Township 10 North, Range 6 East, N. W., and are marked  and some of which are now lying at PACIFIC LUMBER AND SHIPPING COMPANY'S log dump and/or sorting yard at Longview, Cowlitz County, Washington, WEYERHAEUSER COMPANY'S log dumps and/or sorting yards at Tacoma, Pierce County, Washington, Everett, Snohomish County, Washington, and Cosmopolis, Grays Harbor County, Washington; C & E LUMBER COMPANY log dump and/or sorting yard, Bandle, Lewis County, Washington, and some of which are lying at GRAM LUMBER COMPANY'S millsite, Kalama, Cowlitz County, Washington, and some of which have been manufactured into lumber at GRAM LUMBER COMPANY'S millsite and are stored thereon, all of which are in an unknown quantity, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in the logging and removal of said logs; that the name of the owners or reputed owners, are SUNSET LOGGING CO., GRAM LUMBER COMPANY, LOG TRANSPORT, INC., WEYERHAEUSER COMPANY, PACIFIC LUMBER AND SHIPPING COMPANY, and C & E LUMBER COMPANY; that SUNSET LOGGING COMPANY employed claimant to perform labor and render assistance in the logging and removal of said logs upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

The said SUNSET LOGGING CO. agreed to pay to Claimant for such labor and assistance the sum of \$4.15 per hour for straight time work as a choker setter, that said Contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of Claimant, who performed labor upon and assisted in the logging and removal of said logs for the period of November 1, 1969, to November 26, 1969, and the rendition of said services closed on November 25, 1969, and thirty days have not elapsed since said time; that the amount of Claimant's demand for said services is \$383.87, that no part thereof has been paid, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and off-sets, the sum of \$383.87, in which amount he claims a lien upon said saw logs, to secure payment for the work performed in obtaining or securing the said logs, piles or other timber, or manufactured lumber, herein described.

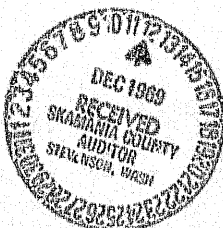
