 the State of Washington does hereby grant, bargain, sell  
 and convey unto Frank M. Warren, of Portland, Oregon  
 his heirs and assigns, the following described shore  
 land of the second class, situate in Skamania County,  
 Washington, to-wit:

All shore land of the second class, owned by  
 the State of Washington, embraced within the following  
 described boundaries, to-wit: - Beginning at the South-  
 west corner of the B. B. Bishop Donation Land Claim in  
 section 21, Township 2 North, range 7 East, W. M.; thence  
 north  $23^{\circ} 30'$  East - 255.8 feet; thence south  $45^{\circ} 46'$  East  
 105.00 feet; thence south  $30^{\circ} 00'$  West, 170.00 feet;  
 thence south  $6^{\circ} 11'$  West, 68.40 feet; thence north  $45^{\circ} 46'$   
 West, 106.2 feet to the place of beginning, containing  
 0.476 acres, more or less according to the survey thereof  
 as shown by the plat and field notes of said descri-  
 bed shore land, filed in the office of the Commissioner  
 of public lands of the State of Washington, at Olympia,  
 Washington, on the 29 day of February, 1896.
