that the above identified owner or reputed owner employed the undersigned to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

Sunset Logging, Inc., Log Transport, Inc., and James Thuney agreed to pay William W. Clevenger for such labor and assistance upon the following terms: \$5.00 per hour up to eight hours per day and time and a half for overtime above eight hours; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of William W. Clevenger, who performed labor upon and assisted in the cutting and removal of said sawlogs as a mechanic upon the equipment used in such operation for the period of 24 days or a total of 235 hours; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said sawlogs between the 6th day of November, 1969, and the 5th day of December, 1969; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 5th day of December, 1969, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$1434.01, and the claimant has further advanced cash in the sum of \$20.95; that no part thereof has been paid except two draws of \$100.00 each, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereof, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$1234.01, in which amount he claims a lien upon said sawlogs described above. William W. Clevenger also claims a lien on all said sawlogs now owned by Sunset Logging, Inc., Log Transport, Inc., and James Thuney of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or curing said logs or timber herein described.
