Notice is hereby given that the undersigned claim the water being, lying or flowing in a creek (no name) which runs in a northerly direction and empties into a small creek near the south line of my land, the South  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the North east quarter of section thirty six Township four north of Range 7 east of Willmarie Meridian, to the extent of one cubic foot per second of time. The water so claimed is for the purpose of irrigating and domestic purposes. The place of diversion is about 200 yards south of the south line of said South  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the Northeast quarter of the said section 36 from whence the water will be diverted by means of flume and ditch by nearest and best possible route to my land.
