Notice is hereby given that the undersigned W. J. Porter of Home Valley, Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon all that certain lumber being about 15,000 board feet in quantity, which was manufactured from saw logs which were cut, obtained and manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington (and is unmarked) which said lumber is now lying at the saw mill of said Wind River Lumber Company, located about one quarter mile from the mouth of Wind River in said Skamania County, State of Washington, for work and labor performed and assistance rendered in manufacturing said saw logs and timber into lumber; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Wind River Lumber Company and that said Wind River Lumber Company through and by its agent Paul Horting employed said W. J. Porter to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: at the wage rate of Two hundred dollars per month which the said Paul Horting agreed to pay the undersigned for such labor and assistance.

That said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the undersigned who performed labor upon and assisted in manufacturing said saw logs and timber into lumber for the period of 20 days between September 13th, 1946 and October 2nd, 1946, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 2nd day of October, 1946, and that thirty days have not elapsed since that time.

That the amount of claimant's demand for such service is One hundred thirty-three & 33/100 Dollars; that no part thereof has been paid, and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$133.33 in which amount he claims a lien upon said lumber.
