Ludloff, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and valuable services rendered to him, hereby has sold and forever quit-claimed in all forms of law to K. Ludloff, his heirs and assigns the one third ($\frac{1}{3}$) interest he has in the Samson Lode Tunnel Claim in the St. Helens Mining District, supposed to be situated in Lewis County, which was discovered and located by him on the (3rd) third day of May 1895 and is recorded in public registers at the County Seat of Lewis County, Wash. the town of Chehalis, Wash. This sale includes all and every right and privilege connected with this claim, but W. W. O'Connor hereby reserves for himself, his heirs and assigns only the five (5%) per cent non-assessable interest which is granted to him by an agreement between both parties, dated and executed Toledo, Wash.
