 Auld and Antonie Auld, his wife, and Nils Olsen
 of the City of Tacoma, in the State of Washington
 and John Auld of the City of _____ in the State
 of California, have bargained, sold, transferred
 assigned and conveyed, and by these presents
 do bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey
 to said William Falkenhagen, his heirs, personal
 representatives and assigns, all those certain
 mining discoveries, claims and interests now
 owned and controlled by the above named
 grantors or any or either of them, in the
 Counties of Lucas, Skamania & Cowlitz, in the State
 of Washington, which mining discoveries,
 claims and interests are particularly described
 as follows:—

1. The Samson Lode Tunnel Claim situated
 in St Helens mining district, so called, supposed
 to be in said Lucas County, discovered and loca-
 ted May 2nd, 1895, by Mrs Mary Ludlogg, Mrs
 Antonie Auld and WWO' Conner, and described
 and bounded as follows:—

Beginning at the tunnel face in the lower
 part of Samson gulch (emptied by snow slide), about
 one mile North to Northwest from a Beaver Swamp
 on the North side of North fork of Toutle or Green
 River near its head waters, on the South slope of
