

Beginning at the South East corner of Mrs Mary R. O'Connor's lode claim on the Samson lode (being the claim last above described), and running thence South 55° East 1500 feet; thence South 55° West 100 feet; thence North 55° West 1500 feet; and thence North 55° East 100 feet to the point of beginning.

Notice of location of this claim was filed and registered in the office of said Auditor May 27th 1895, in Volume 4 of Mining Records, on page 27.

4. Samson North Discovery Claim located and discovered June 10, 1895 by H. Auld, and described and bounded as follows:

Beginning at point of discovery of this claim in the Samson Gulch (emptied by snow slide), which point is at the entrance of the Samson tunnel claim (above described); above a beaver dam on the North fork of Tautle or Green River and about two miles west from where the Cispus trail crosses Quartz Creek; and running thence (without variation) North 35° East 300 feet; thence North 55° West 1500 feet; thence South 35° West 200 feet to center of lode; thence South 35° West 200 feet; thence South 55° East 1500 feet; thence North 35° East 300 feet to the point of beginning.

Notice of location of this claim was filed and registered in said Auditor's office June 15 1895, in Vol. 4 of Mining Records, on page 29.

5. Samson North Extension Claim located and discovered June 10th, 1895 by H. A. Olsen, and described and bounded as follows:-

Beginning at point of discovery of this claim in the Samson Gulch (emptied by snow slide), which point is situated North 55° West and 1500 feet distant from the entrance of the Samson tunnel claim, hereinbefore described; and run-
