11. The Northwest-Discovery Claim of the Samson Excelsior Lode discovered and located June 17, 1895 by J. Ludloff, and described and bounded as follows:-

Beginning at point of discovery about 500 feet west from the Samson Superior Lode discovered in a Gulch torn in the granite stone above the cliffs of Samson gulch, in the upper Touth river basin, about 30 feet North 75° West from the roots of a big windfall, and running thence 300 feet North 5° East; thence 1500 feet North 85° West; thence 600 feet South 5° West; thence 1500 feet South 85° East; thence 300 feet North 5° East to the place of beginning.

12. Southeast-Discovery Claim of the Samson Excelsior Lode discovered and located June 17, 1895 by A. Wold, and described and bounded as follows:-

Beginning at the same point of discovery as the claim last above described and running thence 300 feet North 5° East; thence 1500 feet South 85° East; thence 600 feet South 5° West; thence 1500 feet North 85° West; and thence 300 feet North 5° East to the place beginning.

13. The Northwest-Discovery Claim of the Samson Superior Lode, discovered and located June 17, 1895 by J. Ludloff and described and bounded as follows,
