51. The Southward-Discovery Claim of the Hercules Lode in Skamania County, State of Washington discovered and located June 29, 1895 by F. Ludloff and described and bounded as follows;

Beginning at the place of Discovery in Rock bed on Ghost Lake Creek, one-fourth mile Southward from North Toutle river, upper Toutle Valley, South Slope of Lusk ridge, and running thence 300 feet North 38° East - thence 1500 feet - South 52° West - thence 600 feet - South 58° East - thence 1500 feet - North 52° East - and thence 300 feet - North 38° East - to the place of Beginning. Notice of location of this claim was filed and recorded in said Auditor's Office July 9, 1895, in Vol 4 of Mining Records at Page 69.

52. The Northward-Discovery Claim of the Altamonte Lode in Skamania County, Washington discovered and located August 19, 1895 by F. Ludloff, and described and bounded as follows;

Beginning at the place of discovery above the gulch of gozzly creek, upper North Toutle valley, and running thence 300 feet North 25° West - thence 1500 feet - North 65° East - thence 600 feet - South 25° East - thence 1500 feet - South 65° East - and thence 300 feet to the place of beginning.

Notice of location of this claim was filed and recorded in said Auditor's office in Volume 4 of Mining Records, on Page 220, December 31, 1895.

53. The Southward-Discovery claim of the Altamonte lode in Skamania County, State of Washington. Discovered and located August 19, 1895 by A. Arnold, and described and bounded as follows. Beginning at the same place of discovery as the claim last above described, and running thence 300 feet
