Notice of location of this claim was filed and recorded in said auditor's office December 31, 1895 in Volume 4 of Mining Records on Page 252.

101 The Northwest Discovery claim of the Mendota Lode in Klamath County, Washington discovered and located August 26, 1895 by K. Kidloff and described and bounded as follows: Beginning at the place of discovery on divide between Valley Canyon and Quartzite Creek about one thousand feet West from Union Basin and running thence 300 feet North 80° West; thence 1500 feet North 10° West
