102. The Northeast Discovery claim of the Kennicknick Lode in Skamania County Washington discovered and located August 29, 1895 by K. Riddloff and described and bounded as follows: - Beginning at the place of discovery about 400 feet Northeast from Union basin and running thence 300 feet North 35° West thence 1500 feet North 55° East thence 600 feet South 35° East thence 1500 feet South 55° West; and thence 300 feet to the place of beginning. Notice of location of this claim was filed and recorded in said auditor's office December 31, 1895 in Volume 4 of Mining Records on Page 228.

103 The Southwest Discovery claim of the Kennicknick Lode in Skamania County Washington, discovered and located August 29, 1895 by A. Wold and described and bounded as follows: - Beginning at the same place of discovery as the claims last above described; and running thence 300 feet North 35° West; thence 1500 feet South 55° West thence 600 feet South 35° East thence 1500 feet North 55° East; and thence 300 feet to the place of beginning. Notice of location of this claim was filed and recorded in said auditor's office December 31, 1895 in Vol 4 of Mining Records on Page 252.

104 The North Discovery claim of the Mastiff Lode in Skamania County, Washington discovered and located August 30, 1895 by A. Wold and described and bounded as follows: - Beginning at the place of discovery at the East branch of Bear Creek in Valley Canyon and running thence 300 feet East thence 1500 feet North thence 600 feet West; thence 1500 feet South; and thence 300 feet to the place of beginning. Notice of location of this claim was filed and recorded
