Waterright.

To Whome it may concern:

Know Ye, That I, T. H. Menzie of Stearns County, Wash., do claim the water in a certain creek known as Tater Creek in said County for irrigation purposes and for household & stock use, as follows to wit: I claim in quantity a flow of one hundred cubic feet per minute of time or so much as will fill a box one foot square and hundred feet long once every minute. Said water to be taken from said creek at a point on my own land about 36 rods due west from corner of Sec. 26 Tps 3 N. R. 8 E. W. M. and one rod north from said due west line, and then running southerly over my land, being part of the S 1/4 of said Sec. 26. Said water is to be diverted by flume and ditch.

This waterright is the same as that the one taken by J. H. McElphrean, former owner of said land, and is now used by the undersigned and kept in repair by me, according to law.
