

B. E. Patzer & wife to Henry Bartz.

This Indenture made this 24th day of January 1897, between B. E. Patzer and Maggie, his wife, of the County of Manitowish State of Wisconsin, parties of the first part, and Henry Bartz of the County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin aforesaid, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to them in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have remised, released and quit-claimed, and by these presents do remise, release and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns: All the following described real estate, situate respectively in the St. Helens and Cispus Mining Districts in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit: The Golconda Lode mining claim, 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, located on Golconda Peak $\frac{1}{4}$ mile North east from the Beaver Swamp in Sampson Basin upper North Fork valley, the second creek from Sampson camp in a South easterly direction, in said St. Helens Mining District, according to a certain notice of location, dated on the 18th day of June, 1895, and recorded in the office of Auditor of Lewis County, in the State of Washington, on the 24th day of July, 1895, in Book 4 of Record on page 79; and also recorded in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County, in the State of Washington aforesaid, on the 5th day of October, 1896, in Book 6 of Miscellaneous on page 134. Also the Golconda Lode mining claim, 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, located on the West slope of Lusty Mountain, East from Beaver Swamp, in Sampson Basin, Southeast from Camp Sampson, upper North Fork valley, in the Cispus Mining District, according to a certain notice of location, dated August 23, 1895, and recorded in the office of Auditor of the County of Lewis in the State of Washington, on the 31st of December, 1895, in "4 Record" on page 193; and also recorded in the office of Auditor of the County of Skamania in said State of Washington, on the 5th day of Oct. 1896 in Book 6 of "Miscellaneous" on page 129.
