McKelvey by deed dated May 23, 1939; thence from said point South 63° 24' West 463.66 feet along the North line of the above mentioned highway to the initial point of the tract hereby conveyed; thence from said initial point N. 18° 2' West 290.4 feet; thence South 71° 58' W 150 feet; thence South 18° 2' West 290.4 feet to the northerly line of the Highway; thence North 71° 58' East along the Northerly line of said Highway 150 feet to the initial point of survey.
(Subject to flowage easement granted to the United States of America and to easement for pipe line granted to Stevenson Water Co.)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that J. R. ASHER of Bingen, Klickitat County, State of Washington claims a lien upon a quantity of rafted logs which were fell, bucked and rafted in Skamania County, State of Washington and are now located in rafts U016, UWP6, and rafts U92 to U98, inclusive, at the Steeco Dump in the Big White Salmon River at Underwood, Washington and in rafts 42 to 47 inclusive and rafts DM3, W1 and W2 at the Drano Dump in the Little White Salmon River adjacent to the Columbia River, in Skamania County, State of Washington for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in falling, bucking, skidding and loading said logs; the name of the owner or reputed owner of said logs is ARTHUR W. LEHMANN; that the said Arthur W. Lehmann employed said J. R. Asher to assist in falling, bucking and skidding said logs and loading said logs upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: That said Arthur W. Lehmann employed the said J. R. Asher to assist in bucking said logs and agreed to pay the said J. R. Asher for said services the sum of \$1.50 per M. and agreed to pay the said J. R. Asher the sum of \$2.08 per hour for all other labor performed and assistance rendered and that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said J. R. Asher who performed labor upon said logs between the 25th day of April, 1949 and the 24th day of August, 1949 and the rendition of said services was closed on the said 24th day of August, 1949 and that thirty days have not elapsed since that time and that there is now due and owing the said J. R. Asher from the said Arthur W. Lehmann for such services the sum of \$643.60 and that no part thereof has been paid and that said Claimant claims a lien upon said logs in said amount. That said J. R. Asher also claims a lien upon all other logs and ^{all} real and personal property belonging to the said Arthur W. Lehmann in said Skamania County, State of Washington to secure the payment to him for his services performed in obtaining or securing logs, spars, piles, or other timber, lumber or shingle herein described.
