NOTICE OF CLAIM OF LIEN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 5th day of February, 1951 claimant at the special instance and request of the owners or reputed owners of the following described property commenced to perform labor upon and furnish materials upon said property in the planting of trees, shrubs, vines, plants, hedges and lawns for the improvement of said property, which property is located in Skamania County, State of Washington and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point 190 feet north of meander corner of Section line between Sections 11 and 12, Township 1 North, Range 5 E. W. M., said point being initial point of survey and being the south line of the right of way of the S. P. & S. Railway; thence along the said line south 68°24' west paralleling the center line of said S. P. & S. Railway 100 feet dist. 490 feet; thence south 43° west 200 feet; thence south 15°30' east 150 feet; thence following the meander line of river as follows: south 77°30' east 99 feet; north 77°15' east 99 feet; east 132 feet; north 06°45' east 99 feet; north 63°30' east 198 feet; north 10° west 92.4 feet; south 80°30' east 52.4 feet to the meander corner above described; thence north along section line 190 feet to initial point and place of beginning.

Together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; together with the use of the road leading to the Columbia River and the use of landing thereon at all reasonable times and in any reasonable manner; and together with a water right from the First Spring west of school house near said land, the capacity of pipe at intake to be three and one-half inches and at point of delivery one and one-fourth inches, and including permission to cross property of grantors of party of the first part in laying said pipe, said pipe to be laid at least twelve inches below the surface of the ground;

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: That KENNETH T. GRAY, of Clark County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of sawed lumber, being approximately 6M or 7M feet of fir lumber ties and 2x12's and upon a quantity of logs, being approximately 12 to 15M fir logs, which was cut and manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and is now piled in the millyard of Carl Vollweiler located upon the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 3 North, Range 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ EWM in Skamania County, Washington, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in manufacturing said lumber; that the name of the owner or reputed owner of said lumber is Carl Vollweiler; that said Carl Vollweiler employed said KENNETH T. GRAY to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: The said Carl Vollweiler agreed to pay the said KENNETH T. GRAY for such labor and assistance the sum of \$1.50 per hour being employed as laborer in the said saw mill plant of said Carl Vollweiler and that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said KENNETH T. GRAY, who performed labor upon and assisted in manufacturing said lumber between the 28th day of August, 1951 and the 29th day of September, 1951 and the rendition of said services was closed on the 29th day of September, 1951, and that 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said services is \$133.00 and that no part thereof has been paid and that said claimant claims a lien upon said lumber and logs in the amount of \$133.00; that the said Kenneth T. Gray also claims a lien upon all other lumber, logs, saw mill machinery and all real and personal property belonging to said Carl Vollweiler in said Skamania County, State of Washington, to secure the payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing and manufacturing the said logs, ties and other timber, or lumber herein described.
