### Notice of Water Location

Know all Men by these Presents, That the undersigned, by virtue of the rights given him by the mining laws and statute of the State of Washington, does hereby claim the waters of this stream known as Tottle River and having its source in Spirit Lake (sometimes called St. Helens Lake). The waters hereby claimed flow almost due westerly into County boundary and are located in a Government Reserve in Skamania County, State of Washington. The amount of water claimed hereby is in amount of about 20000 cubic feet per second of time. The purpose of this claim is to divert the waters as above described into a flume or pipe and convey said water through a portion of said reserve to some point within 500 feet of the county line between Skamania County and County boundary and within Skamania County and about 2000 feet from the Tottle River and use same at this point for mining, milling, or manufacturing purposes by electricity or otherwise. It is intended to divert the above described waters by placing in the stream at point of diversion a concrete box of suitable proportion to conduct the water into said flume or pipe. The exact place is near as the undersigned can describe it, is about 1500 feet from the actual outlet of Spirit Lake, which outlet is about four and one half miles slightly east of North of Mt. St. Helens.
