That the said contract has been faithfully performed by claimants and claimants have sold and delivered to A. L. Houghtaling 994,224 feet of yellow fir logs and 1,257,391 feet red fir logs, for which there became due and payable to claimants the sum of \$3,874.53 for stumpage. That all of said saw logs have been so sold, furnished and delivered to A. L. Houghtaling within eight (8) months prior to the filing of this claim of lien, and ceased on the 12th day of May 1939,

That the said A. L. Houghtaling has paid to claimants the sum of \$3,693.02, of which the sum of \$5,193.02 has been credited upon stumpage and the balance thereof, to-wit: the sum of \$500.00 retained and held as a guarantee for the performance of said contract in accordance with the terms thereof. The amount of claimants said claim is the sum of \$3,874.53 and that no part thereof has been paid except the sum of \$3,193.02 and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$681.53, in which amount they claim lien upon said raft of logs.

Notice of Lien

Notice is hereby given, That Carl Krohn and Albert Aalvik, d.b.a. Krohn & Aalvik, of Skamania County, State of Washington claim a lien upon a quantity of saw logs being about 230,000 feet in quantity, which were cut and manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington and are marked thus: H said raft being numbered and identified as KA 17 and are now lying in Rock Creek, between State Highway Bridge of State Highway as now located at original State Highway Bridge at the foot of Vancouver Avenue near the Town of Stevenson in said Skamania County, Washington. That said lien claim is for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in cutting, loading, hauling and rafting said logs. That the name of the owner or reputed owner is A. L. Houghtaling and that the said

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A. L. Houghtaling has employed said claimants to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

To fall, cut, log, haul and raft logs from the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13 and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Tp. 3 N. R. 7 E. W. M., for the sum of \$8.70 for number 1 logs, \$7.70 for number 2 logs and \$6.70 for number 3 logs, \$5.30 for cull logs and \$7.70 for logs known as peewees. Also to construct and maintain all necessary roads to and upon the said real property for the purpose of logging the same for which the said A. L. Houghtaling agreed to pay the cost and expenses in excess of 25 cents per thousand feet for the total amount of logs removed from said land.

Also to raft and prepare for towing all saw logs delivered by Moore Brothers to Rock Creek Landing under another sub-contract, for which the said A. L. Houghtaling promised and agreed to pay to claimants the sum of 50 cents per thousand feet. The said contract was modified on or about the 10th day of February, 1939 to provide for the payment by the said A. L. Houghtaling to claimants of an additional sum of \$1.00 per thousand feet on all classifications of logs removed from Sections 13 and 14 aforesaid. And the said A. L. Houghtaling agreed to pay the said claimants for such labor and assistance in accordance with the terms of said agreement.

That the said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said claimants for a period of eight months immediately preceeding the filing of this claim; that claimants commenced to perform labor and render assistance in securing the said saw logs on the 10th day of August, 1938 and have continued to furnish said labor and assistance since said date, weather conditions permitting. That pursuant to said contract claimants have furnished and delivered to the said A. L. Houghtaling logs from Section 13 and 14 as follows:

13,134 feet number 1 logs
1,038,605 feet number 2 logs
54,992 feet number 3 logs
55,284 feet cull logs
52,222 feet peewees
224,006 feet number 2 logs, under amended agreement,

and has rafted and prepared for towing a total of 822,325 feet upon the Moore Brothers contract above mentioned. Claimants have also constructed and maintained the roadway for the removal of logs on Sections 13 and 14 above mentioned at a total cost of \$1,194.83 and that there was hauled over said road 1,492,245 feet of logs. That the amount of claimants demand for said work and services is \$12,765.28 and that no part thereof has been paid except the sum of \$10,612.37 and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all credits and off sets the sum of \$2,152.91, in which amount claimants claim a lien upon said logs.

That the said contract has been a continuous contract and the payments above specified have been made from time to time and credited upon work previously performed in accordance with the term of said contract. That all labor and service performed and assistance rendered prior to eight (8) months previous to the date of filing this lien have been paid and the sum of money now due and for which this lien is claimed is for work and labor performed and assistance rendered within eight (8) months immediately preceeding the filing of this lien.
