Stickler of the County of Lewis State of Washington, citizen of the United States, do hereby declare and publish as a legal notice to all the world, that I claim and have a valid right to the occupation, possession and enjoyment of all and singular, that tract and parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Skamania in the State of Washington for the exclusive right of way for the purpose of constructing a flume or water ditch from Camp Creek to Bench Blain #1 places claim, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the east end of Gold Spider Quarry claim, and running in a northwesterly direction 1600 ft., thence in a westerly direction 600 ft., across Gold Spider #2, Quarry claim, and thence in a westerly direction 100 ft. on Minnet Quarry claim and thence in a southerly direction 100 ft. on same claim to about the center of said Bench Blain #1.
