The performance of the labor and the furnishing of the materials ceased on the 10th day of November, 1952; said labor performed was of the value of \$560.11 and not more than ninety days have elapsed since said named date, for which labor the claimant claims a lien upon the property hereinbefore described for the said sum of Five Hundred Sixty Dollars and Eleven Cents (\$560.11).
