

### Water Right Notice

1. Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, claims the water, lying, being or flowing in Rock Creek at the first Falls, about  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile above County Bridge across said creek near Stevenson, Wash. to the extent of 500 cubic feet per second of time.
2. The purposes for which said water is to be used are as follows, to-wit: (1) To supply the inhabitants of Stevenson and vicinity with water for household and irrigation purposes.
- (2) To generate power for electric light plant or plants for manufacturing purposes.
- (3) Said water is to be used in Stevenson and the immediate vicinity.
- (3) It is intended to divert the water by means of a pipe or pipes and conveying it to the place of usage.

I the undersigned do hereby give notice that I claim the water in Little Lost Creek to the extent of 1 cubic foot per second of time, for irrigating purposes and household purposes. Said water to be diverted by flume, ditch or pipe. The water so claimed is to be diverted at where a small stream crosses the section line between Secs. 5 & 8 T. 3 N. R. 10 E. W. 46. and about one-tenth of a mile East from the SW corner of Sec 5. Dated this 1<sup>st</sup> day of Nov. 1905.
