Notice Is Hereby Given: That the above named petitioner has commenced an action against the above named claimants in the above entitled court and cause for the condemnation and appropriation of a right of way consisting of the following strips and tracts of land situated in the county of Skamania State of Washington and more particularly described as follows to wit:

A strip of land one hundred feet wide being fifty feet on each side of the center line of the railroad of said petitioner as the same is now located and staked out over and across the Hamilton Donation Land Claim in sections 20 and 19, the N.E. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 and S.W. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 lots 6 and 7 of section 19, The Hardy Donation Land Claim in section 30, all in Twp 2 north, Range 7 East Willamette Meridian and The Hardy Donation Land Claim, the Snook Donation Land Claim and Lot 8 of section 25 Twp 2 north, Range 6 East.
