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## Lis Pendens.

Notice is hereby given that on the 8th day of December 1905 in action was commenced in the Superior Court of the State of Washington, for the County of Skamania, by the filing of a complaint in said court on said date, in which action the Columbia Valley Railroad Co., a corporation named as plaintiff, and the Columbia River Packers Association, a corporation as defendant, the object of said action being to compel said defendant by decree of said court to execute a Deed of conveyance conveying to said plaintiff a strip of land 100 feet in width, over and across the hereinafter described premises for a right of way for the use of said plaintiff upon which to build and operate a railroad, upon payment by said plaintiff of the sum that may be awarded as damages by decree of said court. That said strip of land sought to be condemned and appropriated by said action is particularly described in said complaint now on file in said court, same being a strip 100 feet in width, being 50 feet in width on each side of the center line of the railroad of petitioners as the same is now located and runs over and across Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 in Section 19 in Town 1 North, Range 5 East of the M. & M. in Skamania County, Washington.

That a decree of the court is asked requiring said defendant to execute a conveyance of said premises to plaintiff upon payment of the damages awarded by said court, and upon its failure so to do that a decree of the court in said action shall and operate as such conveyance.
