

Craw, obtained a judgment against the defendant William Shepherd in the Superior Court of Skamania County, Washington in the sum of \$824⁰⁰ principal \$58⁰⁰ attorneys fees \$31⁰⁰ costs, the same bearing interest since then at 10 per cent per annum and pursuant to a writ of execution thereon issued out of said court levied on the interest of the defendant, the said mortgagors, in the said real property mortgaged as aforesaid in said Skamania County and sold the same, the said defendant George W. Craw being the purchaser at said sale, and did further file a transcript of said judgment in the office of the County Auditor of Clarke County in said State where the remainder of the said mortgaged property is situated. That the said judgment and sale was subject and in all respects subordinate to the lien of the plaintiff under said mortgage.
