

to the possession of the property sold to them
 at said sales from the day of sale as provided
 by law, and shall have a writ or writs of resti-
 tution therefor. It is also Ordered that the plaintiff
 do have and recover of and from the defendants
 William Shepherd and Mary E. Shepherd, his wife, such
 sum or sums as may remain unpaid as deficiency
 after the payment of the proceeds of said sales.
 Upon the said sums above mentioned and costs,
 and that execution issue therefor in the manner
 provided by law against any other property of the
 said mortgagors not exempt by law from execution.
 It is also Ordered, Adjudged, and Decreed, that the
 defendants William Shepherd, and Mary E. Shepherd his
 wife and the defendants George W. Crow and M. Collins
 and William Roof their and each of their legal repre-
 sentatives and assigns and all persons claiming
 by, through or under them or either or any of
 them, be and they are hereby foreclosed and barred
 forever of and from any and all equity of redemption,
 and of any and all right, title and interest of in
 and to the said above described real property and
 every part and parcel thereof as against the plaintiffs
 in this action and as against the purchaser or
 purchasers of the same upon the sales hereinbefore
 ordered and provided for, to the end that the said
 real property may be free and clear forever of
 and from all present claim or interest of the said
 defendants and each and all of them as against
 the purchasers thereof at the said sales or otherwise.
 And it is further Ordered that S. M. Beard Jr. and
 he is hereby appointed as Receiver to collect such
 rents as may hereafter become due from the
 defendants M. Collins and William Roof or other persons
 as rent of the said mortgaged property and to hold
 the same for payment upon the amounts due the
 plaintiff as aforesaid, and that said Receiver
 give a bond to the plaintiff in the sum of.
