Notice of Appropriation of Water.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned desiring to avail himself of the rights and privileges provided in Chapters I and II of Title 740 Revisers Annotated Code and Statutes of Washington does hereby appropriate the water being and flowing in and from that certain stream or creek named and commonly known as "Big Duck Creek" to the amount of One hundred feet per second of time, which claim the undersigned makes for himself, his heirs, executors and assigns. The water hereby appropriated to be taken from said stream at or near a place Four (4) miles in a North Westerly direction from the mouth of said "Big Duck Creek" or where the said stream empties into the "White Salmon River" following the course of said stream, or unsurveyed land, in Skamania County, State of Washington. The water to be taken from said place of diversion, viz, near the point where this notice is posted, by means of flumes, pipes and ditches, and lateral flumes, pipes and ditches, to the Town of White Salmon, in Klickitat County, Washington, and to the adjacent country for domestic irrigating and manufacturing purposes and for any and all purposes for which a Town or City waterwork system may be used. The said water or so much of it as may be used from time to time to be stored in a Reservoir located in or near the said Town or City of White Salmon, Wash. from which Reservoir the water to be distributed by means of pipes, ditches or flumes to the Town of White Salmon, Wash. and the neighboring regions for the uses and purposes above named. The right however is reserved of supplying water for domestic purposes, irrigating and manufacturing purposes directly from main pipes, ditches, and flumes and from lateral pipes, ditches and flumes between said place of diversion and said reservoir.
