

Notice of Water Right

To all whome it may concern, notice is hereby given that the undersigned does hereby claim the water being and flowing in Panther Creek in the county of Skamania, State of Washington for the extent of 350 cubic feet of water per second of time. The point of diversion of water from said Panther Creek being described as follows: At a point on the west side of Panther creek at the upper end of an Island that is about 40 rods long and about 3000 feet above where the south line of the reservation crosses Panther Creek and 20 rods south of where line between sections 24 and 25 cross Panther creek, which point of crossing is 80 rods east of Northwest corner of Section 25. This point is about 5½ miles from the mouth of Panther Creek and on the west bank of Panther Creek. The purpose for which said water is hereby appropriated is for the irrigation of land in Panther Creek and Wind River Valleys in Skamania County, State of Washington. The means by which it is intended to divert said water and by means of which said water shall be conveyed are by ditch and flume and pipe. The place or places as near as may be of intended use of said water are as follows: Said water is to be conveyed by ditch flume and pipe as aforesaid from the point of diversion running thence South and southeasterly direction for a distance of about seven miles more or less through the following described land: Part of Township 4 North of Range 7½ East W.M.; part of Township 3 N of Range 7½ E.W.M.; part of Township 3 N of Range 8 E.W.M.

Kollock being first duly sworn, depose and say upon oath say: That I am a citizen of the United States and a competent witness in the courts of the country, that heretofore to-wit: On the 31st day of December 1908 I posted a copy of Notice of Water Right, duly signed by me, a copy of which notice is hereto attached and made a part hereof; that I posted said notice in the following place and manner to-wit: Upon a cedar tree about 2 feet in diameter, by blazing said tree and securely tacking said notice thereon at a place about 3½ feet above the ground, that said tree is situated about 20 feet up stream from the intended point of diversion.
