Therefore it is ordered that said document heretofore filed, purporting to be the last will and testament of said Michael Gundel, deceased, be admitted to Probate as the Last will and Testament of said deceased, and that John Gundel be and he is hereby appointed executor thereof and that Letters Testamentary issue to said John Gundel upon him taking and filing the oath required by law, the said will providing that he be not required to give bonds as executor.
