

A. Hooper to Portland and Northwestern Exploration & Mining Company

This indenture made this 5<sup>th</sup> day of April 1897 between A. Hooper of the county of Lewis, and state of Washington, party of the first part, and the Portland and Northwestern exploration and mining company, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the state of Oregon, party of the second part,

Witnesseth that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath remised, released, and quit-claimed, and by these presents doth remise, release and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns:

All the following described real estate, situate in the St. Helens and Bunker mining district, County of Skamania, and State of Washington, to wit:

Good Hope Lode, first discovery claim, south 45 degrees east M. 1500 feet linear and 800 feet linear on each side, side boundary lines parallel to the centerline locality North Skamania County center of bed of north fork of Lewis river, about 400 yards above the mouth of Jumbo creek. Discovered and located May 27<sup>th</sup> 1896, recorded December 5<sup>th</sup> 1896 in book "C" of Miscellaneous, page 217 by the county auditor of Skamania County.

Also, morning sun lode, first discovery claim south 45 degrees East M. 1000 feet linear and 600 feet linear on each side, side boundary lines parallel to centerline locality North Skamania County center of bed of north fork of Lewis river about a quarter of a mile below mouth of Jumbo creek, discovered and located May 27<sup>th</sup> 1896, and recorded in Skamania County records Dec. 5, 1896 in Miscellaneous, page 216 of book C.
