

J. W. Schully & A. C. Hooper to Chas Bartram and Al Giltfuch

This Indenture, made this the tenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven, Between J. W. Schully & A. C. Hooper of Knox Lewis County, Washington the parties of the first part, and Chas Bartram and Al Giltfuch of Portland Ore the parties of the second part; Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred (\$200⁰⁰) Dollars lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents remise, release, and forever quit-claim unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, all right, title, interest and estate of said first part in and to all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Mining Claim situated in the St. Helens Mining District in Skamania County, Wash, known as the Mountain Fairy No 1 The Location Notice of which has been recorded, in the County Auditor's office in Chehalis Lewis County, Wash, on page 307 of Book 4 of mining claims said claims described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a stake in the center of claim upon which the Location Notice is posted, running North East 300 ft to a stake thence North West 1500 ft to a stake thence South West 300 ft to a post marked N.W. and center stake being the center of the lead lode and of claim thence South West 300 ft to a corner post thence South East 1500 ft to a corner post thence North East 300 ft to the place of beginning, situated on Florence creek about 1600 ft North West of Lake Mita and about one mile South West of Mt Bismark, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the revenues and possessions, remainders and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof.
