

Mary Bennett. Agnes Bennett ^{2nd} and Bird Bennett to Carlstrom & Jettfusachs

This Indenture, made this fifteenth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Ninety Seven Between Mary Bennett, Agnes Bennett ^{2nd} and Bird Bennett of Toledo Washington the parties of the first part, and Chas Carlstrom ^{2nd} Albrecht Jettfusachs of Portland Or the parties of the second part;

Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand Dollars lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents remise, and forever quit-claim unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns all right, title interest and estate of said first parties in and to all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Mining Claim situated in the St Helens mining District in Skamania Co Wash, known as the Mountain Fairy No 2, the location Notice of which has been recorded in the County Auditors office in Stevenson Skamania Co. Wash, said mining claim described and bounded as follows to-wit:

Commencing at the discovery being the center of Florence creek and of claim and upon which the notice is posted thence 300 ft North East to a corner post, thence South East 1500 ft to a corner post thence South West 300 ft to a center post being the center of the lode or vein and of claim, thence South West 1500 ft to a corner post thence North East 300 ft to the place of beginning, situated on Florence Creek about 1600 ft North West of Lake Meta and about one mile South West of Mt-Bismark. Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversions and reversions, remainders and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof.
