Section VI The election of officers shall be by ballot and shall be held at the first meeting in January of each year and the terms of office shall be for one year. Officers elected to office this 10th day of January 1911 shall hold office until the first meeting in January 1912 or until his successor qualifies. It shall require a majority vote to elect officers. Proxy votes shall be considered legal in the election of officers and such other matters as shall come before the association, providing they meet the requirements of section 4 of the constitution. Section VII Any person is eligible for membership in this organization providing they meet the requirements of section 4 of the Constitution. Section VIII. Initiation fees must be paid within ten days from the time the candidate becomes a member.

Know all men by these presents that I, J.C. Mac Innes a citizen of the State of Washington and a resident of White Salmon Klickitat County State of Washington do hereby appropriate from the natural flow of the white salmon River in the State of Washington two thousand (2000) cubic feet per cent of time of the water of said river for manufacturing and irrigation purposes and for the generation of electricity for light, power and all purposes to which electricity may be applied, to be taken from said river at approximately the Northeast corner of the Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10 Township three (3) North of Range ten (10) East Willamette Meridian; the water to be diverted by means of a dam across said river approximately one hundred (100) feet in height; the water to be diverted by means of said dam and from thence conveyed by means of pipes ditches and flumes or combinations thereof down stream on the east side of the stream to a point hereafter to be selected which point shall not be beyond the section line between section fourteen and twenty three township three North range 10 East Willamette Meridian, and at the point hereafter selected will be used for the generation of electricity as hereinbefore set out and thence returned to the river.

In Testimony Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 14th day of February 1911; and have caused this notice to be posted on the east bank of the said white salmon River approximately near the proposed dam site and point of diversion and have caused the same to be recorded in the Auditors Office of Klickitat County State of Washington.
