Water Right

Know all men by these presents that Northwestern Electric Company a corporation of the State of Washington duly authorized and qualified, hereby appropriates from the natural flow of the White Salmon River on the boundary line between Klickitat and Skamania Counties a quantity of said Washington two thousand (2000) cubic feet per second of time of the water of said river for manufacturing and irrigation purposes and for the generation of electricity for light power and all purposes to which electricity may be applied; the said two thousand feet per second of time of water to be taken from said river in the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section ten (10) Township three (3) North of Range ten (10) East of the Willamette Meridian and at or near a point indicated by the posting of this notice, the said water to be taken from the eastside of said river and to be carried down stream by means of flumes, ditches canals tunnels pipes or combinations thereof a distance of approximately one and one half (1½) miles to some point to be definitely selected at a later date and there to be used for power purposes and there to be returned to the river unless needed for irrigation or other purposes a dam not exceeding one hundred fifty (150) feet in height above high water level in the river to be erected at the point of diversion, and hereby appropriating and reserving the right to appropriate and condemn all lands overflowed by the back water resulting from said dam. In testimony whereof, Northwestern Electric Company has caused these presents to be executed in its corporate name by its President and Secretary and the official seal of said corporation to be hereunto affixed this the 15th day of March 1911 and has caused this notice to be posted on the east bank of said river approximately near the point of diversion and dam site herein referred to and has caused a copy of this notice to be recorded in the office of the County Auditor of Klickitat county and in the office of County Auditor of Skamania county.

Power of Attorney

Know all men by these presents that I, Jonathan Allison Holmes of the Town of Copper Cliff in the Province of Ontario, Metallurgist, do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Sarah Estelle Van Alstine Weber, wife of Henry Klink Weber of the Town of Underwood in the State of Washington in the United States of America, my attorney, to do all acts as fully and effectually as I could do if personally present and particularly the following acts, the enumeration of which is not in any way to limit the general powers herein conferred:

1. To purchase, sell, make draw accept endorse discount transfer renew negotiate and in every way deal with cheques, bills of exchange, promissory notes deposit receipts, bonds, debentures, coupons, and every kind of negotiable instrument and security.
2. To subscribe for, accept, purchase, sell pledge, transfer, surrender and in every way deal with shares, stock bonds debentures and coupons of every kind and description and to vote and act in respect thereof.
3. To receive and collect rents dividends, bonuses, profits, interest commission fees salaries debts and claims of every kind and to give receipts and discharges therefor and to distrain for rent and interest.
4. To purchase, rent sell exchange mortgage lease surrender manage and in every way deal with real estate and any interest thereon and to execute and deliver deeds mortgages leases assignments surrenders and other instruments.
5. To make assume purchase discharge assign pledge and in every way deal with mortgages of real or personal property and to execute all powers of sale and other powers therein contained.
