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Water Right.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned claims and appropriates the water flowing in the North Fork of the Lewis River at this point to the extent of twelve hundred (1200) feet per second of time. The purpose for which said water is appropriated is for mining, irrigation, manufacturing and for generating electric current to furnish light and power for cities, towns factories and railroads and for other purposes. The water herein appropriated is to be diverted by means of a dam less than 100 feet high constructed at this point extending from Lot 1 to Lot 3 in Section 26, Tp. 7 North of Range 6 East W.M.; the water thus diverted is to be conveyed in a westerly direction on this side of the river by means of canals, flumes, tunnels and pipes on a proper grade and by a practicable route a distance of approximately seven miles to a point in Section 26, Tp. 7 North of Range 5 East W.M. and used to generate power by the fall of the water into the channel of the river at this location. The undersigned claims the right to use the land as may be necessary and convenient for the construction of diversion works, canals, flumes, pipes penstocks, powerhouses, waterways, tailraces and all other works required to be constructed for the herein specified use of the water appropriated.
