I, Dave Raffety being first duly sworn depose and sayd that I am a citizen of the United States and of the State of Oregon and I am over the age of twenty one years that I reside in the city of Portland Oregon; that I am the identical person who on October 11th 1878 conveyed by deed bearing said date, to Esther S. Lergyea the following described real property situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington, Being part of the Donation Land claim of James M. Findley and wife of Skamania County Washington, described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of said Findley Donation Land claim, thence north forty chains to the Northwest corner of said claim, thence east ten chains to stake thence south forty chains to Columbia River, thence westerly by said river to place of beginning. Containing forty acres more or less. That at the time I executed said deed I was a single man. I further depose and say that I am the grantor named in a deed to Jay R. Sanborn dated October 28th 1879 conveying said above described land to him and at the time of the execution of said deed I was a single man. I further depose and say that since the October 28th 1879 I have been personally acquainted with the said Jay R. Sanborn who on November 3, 1879 conveyed the above described real property by deed bearing date of November 8 1879 to E. S. Lergyea some time known and described as Esther S. Lergyea and that at time the said Jay R. Sanborn executed said last mentioned deed he was a single man.

## Affidavit

State of Washington

County of Skamania, ss. I, the undersigned, James K. P. Wiley, being first duly sworn on oath state as follows: I am 65 years old and in sound mind and memory, my present home is Clifton Oregon. Between the years 1864 and 1885 I have lived in Skamania County State of Washington in the vicinity of Cascades Wash and the Wind River, a tributary to the Columbia River about 11 miles above said Cascades. That during said time when I lived in said Skamania County there were but few white men living in said county and I was well acquainted with most of them, especially with William M. Murphy who took up a Donation Land claim adjoining said Wind River on the east. Said William M. Murphy was married and his wife lived in the east but died shortly after said Murphy came to Cascades and Skamania County, leaving no children, said William M. Murphy having often told me that he had no children and that his wife died before he conveyed his donation claim to the Bradford Brothers in the year 1864. I was also well acquainted with Ashbel G. Bradford, one of the Bradford Family, who lived near said Cascades Wash., and I knew that said Ashbel Bradford was a single man at the time he deeded said Murphy

Donation land claim to Moses Bellman, who in turn afterwards deeded the same to myself and George Miller. I also state that in the various conveyances of said Murphy donation land claim the entire claim was intended to be conveyed, and a correct description could not be gotten at said times, but said conveyances always meaning the whole of said Murphy donation land claim as described in his notification No. 837. That on April 28th 1870, the day when I conveyed my interest in said Murphy donation land claim to George Miller I was a single man and had no children. I also knew one James B. Stephens and know that he had no claim to said donation land claim and the deed as shown to me from William M. Murphy to said Stephens was given for security of a team of horses sold by said Stephens to said Murphy and for nothing else, said Stephens knowing very well that we, myself and George Miller had legal and lawful possession of said Murphy donation land claim.

I make this deposition with my own free will and without coercion and influence of any one and in the presence of the witnesses below mentioned this 31st day of March 1911.
