Notice of Appropriation of Water.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned Mike Thornton claims the water from this stream known as Buck Creek, all of the water running or flowing in said stream to the extent of 30 cubic feet of water per second of time being equal to 1200 miners inches.

The purpose for which said water is appropriated is for power manufacturing household, domestic and irrigation purposes and the place of intended use is the farm or premises of the above named Appropriator which premises are particularly described as follows:

Lot 2 in Section 2 in Township 3 North of Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian. The means by which it is intended to use the water from said stream is a dam which shall be located at a point 500 feet more or less from the mouth of said stream, the water is to be carried by means of pipe, flume or ditch to a point at or near ^{where} said creek empties into the White Salmon River. This notice is posted at the point of diversion on the northeast side of a fir tree which is 500 feet more or less from the place where said stream empties into the white Salmon River.
