Now at this time this cause coming on to be heard upon motion of the plaintiff, she appearing by Murphy Wett & Watts and Govert & Stap, et al her attorneys for a judgment and decree in accordance with the findings of facts and conclusions of law herein filed on the 27th day of June 1902 and it appearing therefrom that the plaintiff is entitled to a decree dissolving the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between plaintiff and defendant. It is therefore Ordered, adjusted and decreed that the marriage between Gertie Britain and J.W. Britain be dissolved and the parties and each of them is freed and absolutely released from the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between them, and all the obligations thereof, and each of said parties plaintiff and defendant are hereby prohibited from intermarrying with any third party for and with the period of six months from the date hereof.
