NOTICE OF LIS PENDENS.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Please take notice that there is a suit pending in the Superior Court of the State of Washington, for Skamania County, wherein Northwestern Electric Company, a corporation, is petitioner, and Henry M. Thompson, A.Y. Marsh and Mary Marsh are claimants, which suit involves the title of and seeks to appropriate and condemn the following described lands:

Beginning at a point in the east boundary line of the west half of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 3, Tp.3 N.R. 10 E.W.M. where a line drawn parallel to and one hundred feet westerly from the line of ordinary high water from

the west side of the White Salmon River intersects said boundary-line; thence running parallel to and one hundred feet distance from the line of ordinary high water on the west side of the White Salmon River to a point located as follows: Beginning at a point south 3 degrees, 1 minute west 2595.32 feet to the quarter-corner and south 85 degrees, 36 minutes west, 745.8 feet from the northeast corner of Section 3, Tp.3 North, Range 10 E. W.M. From said point running thence south 66 degrees, fifty-four minutes west, 51.54 feet; thence north 61 degrees, 53 minutes west, 65.76 feet; thence north 30 degrees, 27 minutes west, 270 feet; thence south 66 degrees, 44 minutes west, 87.08 feet; thence south 19 degrees, 14 minutes east, 370 feet; thence south 75 degrees, 58 minutes east 200 feet; thence south 101 feet; thence south 34 degrees, 8 minutes west 254.91 feet; thence south 40 degrees, 53 minutes west 88.62 feet; thence south 67 degrees, 17 minutes west 196.11 feet; thence west 206 feet, more or less, to a point on the west line of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Sec.3, Tp.3 N.R.10 E.W.M., said point being 275 feet, more or less, north of the bank of the White Salmon River; running thence south along the said west line to the center of the White Salmon River; thence northerly along the thread of the stream to the east boundary-line of the west half of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said Section 3; thence northerly to the point of beginning.
