

## Notice of Water Right

Notice is hereby given that we, the undersigned citizen of the United States, do hereby claim and appropriate the waters in the creek known by the name of Northeast fork of Wind River in Skamania County Washington. We claim 3000 cubic feet per minute of time of the waters now flowing being or to flow in said creek. This creek and the water location and right hereby made is about 4 miles northeast from where the north fork of Wind River empties into the east fork of said Wind River. The place where said water is to be taken out of said stream is about 1000 feet above what is known and called as Triplet Falls on said stream, where this notice is posted on a cedar tree. The waters will be diverted from this point by Flume, pipe or ditch on the west side of said stream and run to a point about 2 miles below said falls where it will be returned to the waters of said stream. The waters so appropriated will be used for domestic, agricultural and power and manufacturing purposes.

## Water Right

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned citizen of the United States has this day in conformity with the acts of congress the laws of the State of Washington and the local customs of said state claimed taken possession and appropriated and does hereby claim, locate and appropriate two thousand cubic feet per second of time of the waters lying being and flowing in the stream known as the main fork of the Cispus River which said stream is situated in the county of Skamania Washington, the same being the stream on the left bank of which this notice is posted. This notice is posted on a cedar tree about one half mile below the confluence of the North fork of the Cispus and the main Cispus river. The purpose for which said water is claimed and appropriated and for which the same will be used, are for mining, milling manufacturing industrial, irrigation and for creating power to be used for mining mill milling industrial and irrigation purposes and for creating electricity for the purpose of supplying cities and towns and villages with heat light and power, for supplying power for operating railroads and other means of transportation and for all and every public use and service to which water or water power or electricity generated from water power can in any way be used. Notice is further given that the undersigned pursuant to this appropriation intends to divert 2000 cubic feet of water per second of time from said stream, at or near the point where this notice is posted and to cause said quantity of water to flow therefrom in a westerly direction about twenty two miles along the right shore to power house site. The means by which it is intended to divert said water are dams flumes pipes ditches siphones and conduits. This notice has been executed in duplicate and one copy thereof will be filed in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County Washington.

#### Notice of Reservoir Appropriation.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned citizen of the United States of America this day in conformity with the acts of congress the laws of the state of Washington and the local customs of said state claimed located and appropriated and do hereby claim locate and appropriate a reservoir site on the main Cispus river commencing at the head of the first falls on the main Cispus river about one half mile below the confluence of the Muddy fork of the Cispus river and the main Cispus river and continuing up the river to the Mount Adams creek trail crossing a distance of about six miles, and the undersigned also claims located and appropriated and takes possession of all the valley on both sides of the bed and channel of the main Cispus river which may be submerged by said reservoir site, the intention being to store in said reservoir seventy five thousand million cubic feet of water. The purpose for which said reservoir site is claimed and appropriated and for which the same will be used is to store water for mining manufacturing industrial irrigation and for creating power to be used for mining milling manufacturing irrigation purposes and for creating a water power for the production of electricity to be used for creating electric power and electricity for the purpose of supplying cities towns and villages with heat light and power, for furnishing cities towns and villages with water and for water works and for irrigating lands, for supplying power for the operation of railroads and other means of transportation and for all and every public use and service of which water of water power or electricity generated from water power can in any way be used. Notice is further given that the undersigned pursuant to this appropriation intends to construct dams ditches pipes flumes and all other necessary works for the creation and completion of a storage reservoir. A copy of the notice of appropriation is posted on a cedar tree on the left shore at the head of the first falls below the junction of the Muddy fork with the main Cispus river. This notice has been executed in duplicate and a copy thereof will be filed with the county auditor of Glauania County Wash.
