

From A. Hooper to Gus Barsch

This Indenture made this 15th day of November 1897 Between
A. Hooper of Kenab Wash, the party of the first and Gus Barsch of
Orest and Or party of the second part

Witnesseth: That the said party
of the first part for and in Consideration of the sum of One
Hundred and Ten Dollars lawful Money of the U.S. of America
to one in hand paid by the said party of the second part the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these present covenants
release and forever quit claim unto the said party of the second
part, and to his heirs and assigns, all right, title, interest and
estate of said first party A. Hooper in and to all that certain
Mining Claim situated in Skamania County Wash, and in the
St. Helens Mining District and particularly bounded and
described as follows to wit:

Beginning at Discovery at the Center of what is known
as Erwin Creek a tributary of Lewis River about one mile South
East of Lake Matta and running 1500 ft in a North westerly
direction and 300 feet on each side of center of said river
and known as the Hidden Treasure Lode. Location Notice of
which has been recorded in the Auditor's office at Stevenson
Skamania County Washington.

Ingether with all and singular, the tenements
and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise apper-
taining, and the reversions, remainders, rents, issues and
profits thereof.

To Have and to Hold all and singular the said
premises together with the appurtenances, unto said party of
the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever.
