Know all Men by These Presents: That Augusta Hayden (formerly Augusta Rathbone and mother and heir at law of Charles Rathbone decd) of Shwaco, Pacific County State of Washington in consideration of Ten Dollars to her paid by Ella Rathbone (wife of Charles Rathbone decd) of Washougal Washington do hereby promise release and forever quit-claims unto the said Ella Rathbone all my right, title and interest in and to the following described parcel of real estate situate in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit: "All of the following described mining property to wit:

Beginning at the centre of the East Fork of the North Fork and running South Easterly direction 750 feet to stake on Centre of said Lake Koonsee as the last chance hole and 300 feet on each side of Centre of said hole, said mining claim containing ten acres of The Mining Claim discovered and recorded at Shwaco Skamania County, Washington, November 29 "1895 at 10 o'clock P. M. By R. J. Kuntore and Kuntore as the Kuntore Mining Claim.

To Have and to Hold the same together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said Ella Rathbone and to her heirs and assigns forever.
