Relocation Notice ✓

Notice to Whom it May concern: The undersigned Harvey McMunn hereby gives notice that he hereby appropriates for himself his heirs and assigns, waters of the East fork of the Lewis River _____ (500) five hundred cubic feet per second _____ flows through Skamania and Clarke Counties, Washington. That the purposes for which said waters are hereby appropriated are to generate power for mining, manufacturing, Irrigation and domestic and _____ practical uses, and for the production of electrical energy for power and light for cities and towns and for supplying water to same for fire protection and domestic uses. Also to farmers and others. That said waters hereby appropriated by the undersigned are intended to be stored by means of dams across the said river wherever practical within the following distance along the said stream, extending from a place at or near the west line of sec. 19, T. 4 N. R. 5 E. W.M. where said waters flow over the Falls known as Sunset Falls Thence for a distance of 3 miles easterly from the west line of Skamania County Wash. with the meander of said stream including the streams entering the east fork of the Lewis River within this distance and for similar purposes it is intended wherever necessary to construct dams to hold and to divert the water to pipes ditches and flumes and carried to where uses. And it is intended to construct a dam over and above the said sunset falls (75) seventy five feet high. to store and divert the waters of the said river to pipes flumes and ditches on either side of said river to be conveyed to the west line of sec. 19 T. 4 N. R. 5 E. W.M. and there run through turbines for the uses herein before mentioned. The undersigned his heirs and assigns by reason of this notice also claims and appropriates the riparian rights and sufficient land which may be necessary for reservoirs dam sites

pipe lines flumes and ditches upon either side of the said stream and adjacent thereto and extending from the west line of sec.19 T.4 N.R.5 E. W.M. in Skamania county, State of Wash. to where the east fork of the Lewis river flows and across the north and south center line of T.4 N.R.5 E.W.M.
