The lots 10 and 11 in block 6 of the Town of Shumner, Skamania County, State of Washington as shown by the official plats of said town now on file and of record in the office of the Auditor of said County and State.

Together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and also all our estate, right, title and interest in and to the same. To Have and to Hold the above described and granted premises unto the said Adolph Chamberlain his heirs and assigns forever.

And we the grantors above named do covenant to and with the above named grantee his heirs and assigns, that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances, and that will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall Warrant and forever defend the above granted premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
