Notice of Water Appropriation

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned citizen of the United States has this day in conformity with the acts of Congress, the laws of the state of Washington and the local customs of said state, claimed taken possession of located and appropriated and does hereby claim take possession of locate and appropriate two thousand cubic feet per second of time of the water lying being and flowing in the stream known as and named Main Cispus River which said stream is situated in the County of Skamania in the state of Washington, the same being the stream on the left bank of which this notice is posted. A copy of this notice is posted on a cedar tree on the left shore about one half mile below the confluence of the Muddy

fork of the Cispus and the main cispus river at the head of the first falls. The purpose for which said water is claimed and appropriated and for which the same will be used are for mining, milling, manufacturing, industrial, irrigation, and for creating water power to be used for mining millin manufacturing industrail irrigation purposes and for the creating a water power for the production of elecricity to be used for all public domestic and industrial uses and for creating electricity for the purpose of supplying cities towns and villages with light heat and powr and for furnishing public service corporations with light heat and power and for all other public uses for which electricity can be applied. for supplying poer for the o operation of rialrods and other means of transportayion and for all and every public use an and service for which water, or water power, or elctricity generated from water power can in any way be used. Notice of water Appropriation.

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned citizen of the United States has this day in conformity with the Acts of Congress the laws of the state of Washington and the local customs of said state claimed taken possession and appropriated and does hereby claim, the possession and appropriate a reservoir site on the Main cispus river commencing at the head of the first falls on the main cispus river about one half mile below the confluence of the Muddy fork of the cispus and the main cispus river and continuing up the main cispus river to the Mount Adams and Johnson Creek trail crossing a distance of about six miles. The undersigned also claims locates and appropriates and takes possession of all of the valley on both sides of the bank and channel of the main cispus river which may be submerged by said reservoir site the intention being to store in said reservoir site seventy five thousand million cubic feet of water. The purpose for which said reservoir is claimed and appropriated and for which the same will be used is to store water for mining milling manufacturing irrigation and for creating a water power to be used for mining milling manufacturing irrigation purposes and for creating a water poer for the purpose of supplying cities towns and villages with water, light, heat and for furnishing public service corporations with light, heat and power and for all other uses for which electricity can be used for supplying power for the operation of Railroads and other means of transportation.
