

W. E. Satterfield & Chas. H. Munclon to J. P. Manning

This Indenture, made the 20th day of May in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven between W. E. Satterfield and Charles H. Munclon of the County of Clarke and State of Washington, parties of the first and J. P. Manning of the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon, party of the second part. Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quit-claimed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quit-claim unto the said J. P. Manning said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns the Culger Claim as located, surveyed, recorded and held by said parties of the first part, situated in Copper Creek Mining District, Skamania County, State of Washington and better known and described as follows:

Lying on the north Bank of Charles Creek, about 600 feet East from the point where the East Fork of the Canyon Creek empties into the said Charles Creek: and bounded on the North by a claim known as the Jesse Poole claim on the west by a claim known as the Raymond claim, filed by D. Ward; on the South by a claim known as the Raymond claim, located by Fred Hunt; and on the East by a claim known as the Teo Claim filed by Margaret M. Ward. The said claim was located by said W. E. Satterfield and Charles H. Munclon, on the 6th day of October A.D. 1896, and the Location Notice of said Claim was recorded on the 12th day of November, 1896, on Page 252 of Book "6" of Records of Miscellaneous Mining Claims of the County of Skamania, State of Washington. Said claim being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point in the center of the Southern boundary on Charles Creek marked by a posted Notice: thence Easterly, 200 feet to the South East-corner: thence Northerly, 1500 feet to the North East-Corner: thence Westerly, 300 feet to north center Stake: thence Westerly from north center stake 300 feet to North west-corner: thence Southerly, 1500 feet to South west-corner: thence Easterly, 200 feet to South center Stake. the place
